SAME PERMITS, NEW SYSTEM

Earlier this week we rolled out a new system to make the issuing of track meeting and practice permits easier. They are now generated via an online database and emailed directly to the track contact person.

What this means is that we've been able to integrate features such as a partially completed cancellation form, which you can use to advise Marsh Advantage in the event that bad weather or other factors intervene in your plans.
